1. Sign up for Family Connection

- a. Go to <http://connection.naviance.com/clovisnorth>
- b. Type in your registration code
- c. Type your email address and create a password
- d. In the future, you will sign in under “return user” and will no longer need your registration code.

2. Complete your grade-level Career Assessment and Review the Findings

- a. 9th grade: Learning Styles Inventory
- b. 10th grade: Do What You Are
- c. 11th grade: Career Interest Profile

3. Complete your Game Plan

- a. Under “About Me”, select “My Game Plan” from the menu
- b. Complete the survey and review with your counselor

4. Select Prospective Colleges

- a. Under “About College”, select “College Search” from the menu
- b. Complete the Survey. When completed, click “Show Matches”
- c. Look under “Colleges that Match Your Criteria” and click on “Pick” next to the colleges that interest you. Choose all that are of interest. At the very least, choose five.

5. Practice SAT/ACT Tests

- a. Under “About College”
- b. Click on “test preparation”
