## **ASVAB**

The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) is a multiple choice test used to determine qualification for enlistment in the United States Armed Forces. As with other tests, how much you have learned in school through the years and your motivation will determine results. The ASVAB is given once a year on the Clovis North campus. To take the exam, students must be in the 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade and have a permission slip signed by parents and teachers. Students may sign up in the counseling center.

## **ROTC**

ROTC stands for Reserve Officer Training Corps. It is a college program offered at more than 1,000 colleges and universities across the United States that prepares young adults to become officers in the U.S. Military. In exchange for a paid college education and a guaranteed post-college career, cadets commit to serve in the Military after graduation. When enrolled in ROTC you learn first-hand what it takes to lead others, motivate groups and how to conduct missions as a military officer. If interested, meet with a recruiter during your junior year to learn more about the application process.

## **Military Service Academy Information**

If you are a student interested in pursuing a college education at a United States Service Academy, you are encouraged to attend the annual Academy Night held at the Clovis Unified District Professional Development Building. The Academy Night typically takes place in the fall of each year.
