OPEN  **2017 EECU STUDENT GRANT PROGRAM** In order to apply for a grant, the student must be a member of EECU as of June 8, 2017. The program is open to EECU members pursuing an education after high school. Fifty students will receive a \$2000 grant.

The Scholarship Committee will consider those students who meet the following eligibility requirements and proof of intent: Parent must be a member in good standing with EECU.
