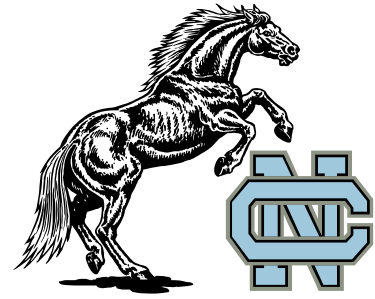


# ASPIRE TEST

The Clovis North Educational Center counseling staff recommends that your son/daughter take the ASPIRE test as a 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and/or 11<sup>th</sup> grader. This test provides an excellent opportunity to participate in a National testing program, and can be an effective diagnostic tool. There is no passing score for this test. Uses for the ASPIRE are as follows:

- A practice test for the ACT test
- Measure of College and Career Readiness
- Addresses questions about the strengths and weaknesses of your student in four academic areas: English, Mathematics, Reading, and Science
- Allows students to determine if they are on target for college readiness as they prepare to take the ACT test and engage in college planning.

## Please be aware of the following:

- The ASPIRE and the PSAT are given on consecutive days.
- The ASPIRE test encompasses the entire school day, 7:45a.m.-2:40p.m.
- Students involved in co-curricular activities are expected to complete the test before being excused.
- No refunds should a student move, decide not to take the test once registered, or fail to show up.

For the 2018-19 school year, the ASPIRE will be given on **Thursday, October 11, 2018**. Please return this form and **\$35.00, check payable to Clovis Unified School District**.

Last day to sign up for the exam is **Friday, April 27, 2018**.
