- Artwork must be the student's original work not previously entered in this competition, and must not have been published anywhere in any form, including online.
- Student name is not to appear on the artwork. Entries need to remain anonymous.
- Students **must submit** a 25-100 word explanation of how their artwork ties in with the theme.
- Art can be mounted on card stock or poster board (No frames, glass, or perishable items allowed).
- Maximum size is 16" x 20".
- Artwork needs to be picked up at the Fresno County Superintendent of Schools, 1111 Van Ness Avenue, Fresno, during the week of February 14-18, 2022 from 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.
