Please read and complete this form with all necessary signatures. It is our expectation that students abide by all dance and school/district rules. By signing below both parent/guardian and student are acknowledging they are aware that all school rules apply as this is a school event. Students who do not follow the dance guidelines and school/district rules will be asked to leave the dance. Granite Ridge wants to provide an environment where all students feel safe and that exemplifies character.

1. **Each student must have this form filled out and turned in to purchase a dance ticket. Students must also be in good standing in order to purchase a ticket. (No F's on the 6-week progress report; no suspensions.)**
2. **Tickets may be purchased beginning Nov 9th on Revtrak. The link for tickets will be on the CNEC Website and in Activities. Contracts will need to be signed and turned in after you purchase your ticket. Please have proof of purchase. The last day to purchase tickets is November 16th.**
3. **Attire/Dress Code:** At all dances, students must be dressed appropriately. If a student has any questions or thinks an outfit may be questionable, please see Mrs. Genco in the Activities office.
4. A student must always exhibit and maintain class and dignity, be cordial, use appropriate language, and act and dance appropriately. Students who dance or behave inappropriately will be escorted out of the dance, parents/guardians will be called, and money will not be refunded.
 - a. Dancing may not be sexually explicit. This means no freaking, grinding, etc.
 - b. Dancing may not be dangerous. No moshing, slamming, getting on someone's shoulders, etc.
 - c. Dancers must be vertical when dancing.
5. Granite Ridge is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged items during the dance.
6. Students suspected of being in possession of a weapon, tobacco products, paraphernalia or a controlled substance, and/or under the influence of a controlled substance may be in violation of the Zero Tolerance policy and will be subject to an investigation. If found to be in possession or under the influence, students will be removed from the dance immediately, face school disciplinary action and the matter will be referred to law enforcement.

I understand and agree that, as a condition of purchasing a ticket and attending Granite Ridge's dance, I must abide by the above expectations for dress and behavior. I understand there will be consequences for behavior and zero tolerance violations, which could result in losing privileges, detention, suspension and/or expulsion. I also understand and agree that I will accept and support the decision of the administration as they interpret expectations.
