II. Transition Services

Mr. Kevin Miller (Transition Coordinator) presented on the purpose of the Transition Department. Mr. Miller discussed how LCAP funds were designated to serve the 3 subgroups (1. Foster Youth/Homeless, 2. SED and 3. EL) students. The transition team works with students who are dealing with a variety of issues such as anxiety, homeless, parents incarcerated, depression, anger management, lack of motivation, academic support, isolation, etc. The transition team utilizes a variety of approaches to support students in need. The goal is to provide assistance, support, and mentorship to eventually remove interventions in hopes of students becoming successfully independent.

III. Mental Health Awareness

a. Student Support and Services

Mrs. Julie Barrett (Mental Health Counselor) reviewed the services available to all students on campus. Mrs. Barrett discussed the increase in students who are being referred to Exodus and how we service students with mental health concerns at our site.
