- May 1  **CAL AGGIE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP** Students entering UC Davis as freshmen or transfer students from California, Oregon or Washington may be eligible to receive achievement scholarships as determined by their local alumni committee. Award amounts range from \$1,000 to \$4,000. Top choice candidates from each region may also be nominated for the \$10,000 Blue and Gold Leadership Scholarship (\$5,000 disbursed over two years). CAAA has awarded scholarships to UC Davis students since 1934. Alumni from each of 28 regions review the scholarship essays, interview candidates and select the finalists.
