<b>CREDIT RECOVERY ELIGIBILITY</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Must be an enrolled student in CUSD.</li> <li>▪ Incoming students in grades 10 – 12 that <b>must repeat a course</b> due to D or F.</li> <li>▪ If deficient in credits/required courses for graduation.</li> </ul>
<b>ORIGINAL CREDIT ELIGIBILITY</b>	<p>General criteria for an Original Credit course in Summer School:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o An impacted schedule for the following school year <b>and</b></li> <li>o 3.0 Semester GPA (unless otherwise indicated for special circumstances) <b>and</b></li> <li>o Self-discipline, self-motivation, ability to work independently</li> </ul>
<b>LUNCH</b>	<p>Lunch will be provided the same as during the regular school year</p>
<b>ATTENDANCE</b>	<p>Students are required to attend the full class hours on a daily basis.          Monday - Thursday</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>ONLY 2 DAYS OF INSTRUCTION CAN BE MISSED. Work must be made up.</b>  <b>Any further absences will result in being dropped from Summer School.</b>  <b>Student will be dropped after 2<sup>nd</sup> absence</b></p> <p><b>Absence = Family vacation, court, illness, school sponsored function, sent home for dress code or conduct violation.</b></p>
<b>STUDENT CONDUCT &amp; DRESS CODE</b>	<p><b>All Clovis Unified School District rules will be enforced during Summer School including CUSD Dress Code</b></p> <p><b>Conduct:</b> Students are required to abide by the school code of conduct.          Infractions will result in disciplinary actions:</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;"><i>Teacher warning</i>  <i>Meet with the Principal</i>  <i>Being sent home = 1 absence</i>  <i>Suspension = removal from the Summer Session</i>  <i>Zero tolerance offenses will be referred for further disciplinary action</i></p> <p><b>Dress Code:</b> Students are required to comply with the district-wide dress code when attending course appointments.  <i>Students will be sent home if attend school out of dress code which equals one absence</i></p>
<b>TRANSPORTATION</b>	<p>Will be provided. See CUSD Website for details.</p>

<b>TRANSCRIPT</b>	<p><b>Drop Procedures with no credits earned:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Drop before 1 week – Not recorded on HS Transcript</li><li>• Drops after 1st week: Record Class with NG (No Grade)</li></ul> <p>Once a course is completed, grades and credits will be posted on the students' transcript.</p> <p><u>Summer School grade postings are permanent and may not be deleted.</u></p> <p>Summer School courses may be repeated at the school site <b>ONLY</b> if the grade earned was a D or F.</p>
