IMPORTANT DATES	<p>Independent Study Summer School BEGINS Tuesday, June 11, 2019 ENDS Wednesday, July 24, 2019 All student work is to be completed and turned in to the student's teacher by 5:00pm on Wednesday, July 24, 2019.</p> <p>Tuesday and Wednesday, June 11th and June 12th Each teacher will schedule a one-hour orientation/enrollment on Tuesday or Wednesday. Any student who fails to meet their teacher on one of the orientation/enrollment days will not be guaranteed admission into Independent Study Summer School. <u>This is also counted as the 1st week of IS.</u></p> <p>ADDITION: Incoming 9th Graders taking Health will attend an orientation session at either <u>Clovis High or Alta Sierra</u> before the end of the regular school year. Parents are required to attend. Dates and times will be mailed to students' home.</p>
CLASS APPOINTMENTS	<p>8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Tuesday or Wednesday Scheduled weekly appointments: 1-Hour Minimum.</p>
NOTIFICATION	<p>Students should be contacted by their Independent Study Teacher close to the end of the school year. If the IS Teacher has not made contact by June 7th, please call the Independent Study Office. The Independent Study Summer School phone numbers will be posted on school/district websites.</p>
CREDIT RECOVERY ELIGIBILITY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Must be an enrolled student in CUSD. ▪ Incoming students in Grades 10 – 12 that <u>must repeat a course</u> due to D or F. ▪ If deficient in credits/required courses for graduation.
ORIGINAL CREDIT ELIGIBILITY	<p>Any student who needs an Original Credit course due to employment, an impacted school schedule, or special circumstance.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Must attend a comprehensive school site. ▪ Counselor will determine if student meets criteria for Original Credit. <p>General criteria for an Original Credit course in Summer School:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ An impacted schedule for the following school year <u>and</u> ○ 3.0 Semester GPA (unless otherwise indicated for special circumstances) <u>and</u> ○ Self-discipline, self-motivation, ability to work independently
HOW MANY CREDITS?	<p>9th, 10th, and 11th grade students may take 10 credits (1 full year course or 2 semester courses).</p>
ATTENDANCE	<p>Students may miss only one appointment no matter what the reason or emergency. Student will be dropped on the 2nd absence. <u>NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE!</u></p>

<p>STUDENT CONDUCT AND DRESS CODE</p>	<p>All Clovis Unified School District rules will be enforced during Summer School including CUSD Dress Code</p> <p>Conduct: Students are required to abide by the school code of conduct. Infractions will result in disciplinary actions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>Teacher warning</i> <i>Meet with the principal</i> <i>Being sent home = 1 absence</i> <i>Suspension = removal from the summer session</i> <i>Zero tolerance offenses will be referred for further disciplinary action</i> <p>Dress Code: Students are required to comply with the district-wide dress code when attending course appointments.</p> <p>Students will be sent home if attend school out of dress code which equals one absence</p>
<p>AGREEMENT FORM</p>	<p>To be enrolled in Independent Study Summer School, the parent/guardian and student must sign a SUMMER SCHOOL AGREEMENT NO LATER THAN JUNE 19th.</p> <p>Students will receive the Agreement Form at the first appointment.</p> <p>Any student who does not have parent's signature by their second appointment will be dropped from Independent Study Summer School.</p>
<p>TRANSCRIPT</p>	<p>Drop Procedures with no credits earned:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drop before 1 week – Not recorded on HS Transcript • Drops after 1st week: Record Class with NG (No Grade) <p>Once a course is completed, grades and credits will be posted on the students' transcript.</p> <p><u>Summer School grade postings are permanent and may not be deleted.</u></p> <p>Summer School courses may be repeated at the school site ONLY if the grade earned was a D or F.</p>
